Our Mission

Chrysalis serves people navigating barriers to the workforce by offering a job-readiness program, individualized supportive services, and paid transitional employment. We empower our clients on their pathway to stability, security, and fulfillment in their work and lives.

The Investment

Over the next two years we will **engage** with our clients, staff, volunteers, customers, and donors to respond to their changing needs; **enhance** our programming and infrastructure to build upon what we've learned; and **expand** by finding new ways to bring our programming to more communities. During this time, more than 6,250 jobs will be secured by Chrysalis clients, reaching an average wage of \$19.11 an hour by 2023.

Change We Need

Southern California needs quality jobs for working age adults impacted by systemic barriers, including identity-based barriers (e.g. racism), homelessness, inequitable education, involvement with the justice system, social/economic disadvantage, and immigration status, and who have experienced a disproportionate economic disruption as a result of the pandemic.

Locally, nearly 64,000 individuals are unhoused, and most state that the leading factor in their experiencing homelessness was job loss or economic hardship.

Employment is also a key factor in reducing recidivism rates; however, justice-involved individuals (1 in 3 Americans) face significant barriers to reentering the workforce.



Our Plan

- Improve programming and increase client income results. We will formalize a hybrid service model and focus on career pathways for clients.
- Expand services to new regions. Chrysalis will bring transitional job opportunities with the Roads program to San Bernardino and Riverside counties with the potential for further growth across Southern California.
- Invest in infrastructure and resource needs to ensure Chrysalis is sustainable and inclusive.
 We will build on our strong foundation with a focus on staff salaries and support, DEI, and resource development.

- A strong history and network of engaged stakeholders on which to build. Chrysalis has been a leader in the fields of workforce development and employment social enterprise for nearly 40 years.
- A tested model and robust data systems to inform program enhancements. Incorporating the voices of clients and volunteers, Chrysalis will enhance our programming to build an effective model for our new hybrid economy that focuses on quality employment and family-sustaining wages.
- An expansion track record. Chrysalis has grown steadily over the last decade, opening new centers and co-located offices, as well as launching new business lines and programs. We're excited to bring our services to new audiences and communities.
