## Background:

CalOptima Health surveyed over 20 shelter and navigation centers in 2022. Of those shelter providers, 78% stated that it was very difficult or somewhat difficult to staff their non-social service openings.

## Objectives:

- Build a workforce capacity for future CalAIM, Community Supports, and ECM Initiatives so that those providers are able to more effectively meet their service goals.
- Provide transitional employment opportunities for individuals experiencing barriers to employment.

## **Program Overview**

- 1. Recruitment
  - a. Program candidates will be recruited from a pool of existing Chrysalis program participants who are interested in these employment opportunities.
- 2. Screening
  - a. May include an application process to identify candidates who meet the selection criteria, as well as screening for soft skills and fit for the role.
- 3. Job Preparation & Training
- 4. Temp-to-Perm Job Placement
- 5. Transition to Permanent Hire
  - a. Sites are encouraged to consider Chrysalis workers as temp-to-perm candidates and to permanently hire on workers at the end of their transitional job term, or sooner if a permanent opening becomes available before the end of a worker's term.
- 6.All program components are offered at no charge to the site.
