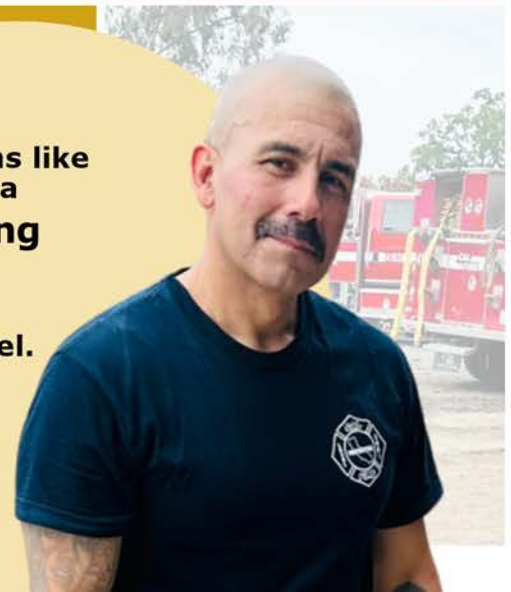
SAFEKEEPING

Our social enterprise bridges the gap between unemployment and sustainable careers, fostering a sense of growth and community.

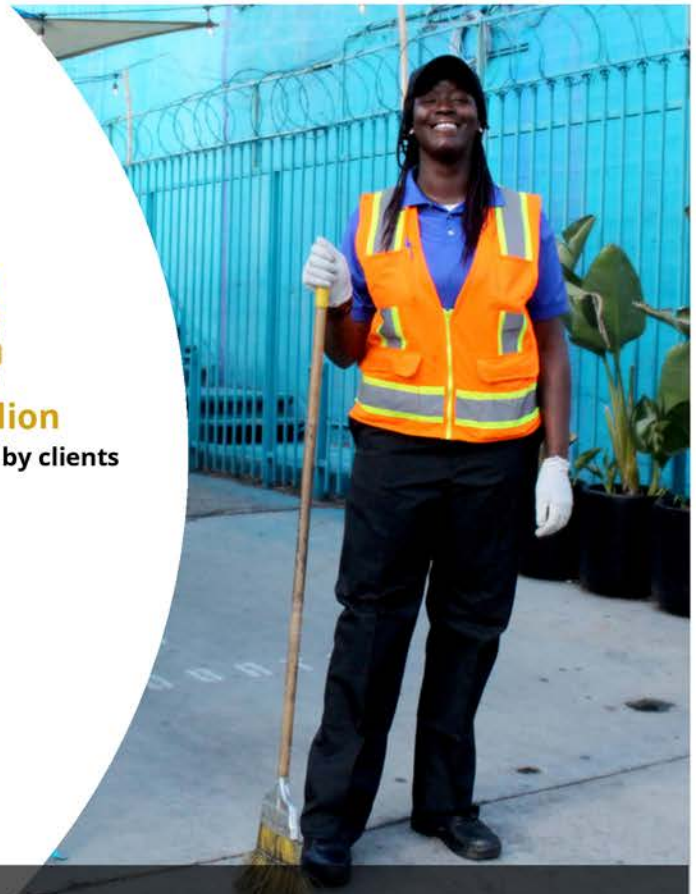
